On November 9, 2017, Hearing Board Chair, Jerry Boren, acting for and on behalf of the Central Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from November 9, 2017, through December 8, 2017. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 1080, 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4354, and allowed for continued glass manufacturing without a certified CEMS until such time that it can be certified.

B. <u>C-17-30E</u> - CertainTeed Corporation

On November 20, 2017, Hearing Board Chair, Jerry Boren, acting for and on behalf of the Central Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance for November 21, 2017. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 1080, 2070, 2201, 2520, 4101, and 4354, and allowed for continued glass manufacturing while bypassing the emissions control systems to conduct preventative maintenance on the electrostatic precipitator.

C. <u>C-17-32E</u> - Pacific Ethanol Madera LLC

On November 29, 2017, Hearing Board Chair, Jerry Boren, acting for and on behalf of the Central Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from November 29, 2017, through December 1, 2017. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070, 2201, and 2520, and allowed for continued ethanol fermentation while the RTO is down for preventative maintenance.
