  - A. <u>C-17-09E</u> Guardian Industries Corp

On March 15, 2017, Hearing Board Chair, Mr. Jerry K Boren, acting for and on behalf of the Central Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from March 16, 2017, until March 18, 2017. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4101 and allowed for continued glass manufacturing with excess visible emissions while the exhaust stream bypasses the emissions control systems so maintenance can be conducted on the electrostatic precipitator.
