11. The Central Region Hearing Board heard and granted the following emergency variances since the June 21, 2017, hearing:

A. C-17-18E - Guardian Industries Corp.

On August 2, 2017, Hearing Board Chair, Jerry Boren, acting for and on behalf of the Central Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from August 2, 2017, until August 5, 2017. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, 4101, 4354, and allowed for continued glass manufacturing with excess visible emissions while the exhaust stream bypassed the emissions control systems so maintenance could be conducted on the electrostatic precipitator (EP).

B. C-17-19E - CertainTeed Corporation

On August 16, 2017, Hearing Board Chair, Jerry Boren, acting for and on behalf of the Central Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from August 16, 2017, until August 23, 2017. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 1080, 2070, 2201, 2520, 4001, 4101, 4354, and allowed for continued glass manufacturing without an operating or functional Opacity Continuous Emissions Monitoring System.
