5. The Central Region Hearing Board approved the following emergency variance order:

A. Docket C-07-08E – Rio Bravo Fresno

On June 21, 2007, Hearing Board member, Mr. Gerry Mulligan, approved an emergency variance effective from June 21, 2007, to June 23, 2007. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, and 4101, and allowed the continued operation of the subject EP without all fields as required while the EP was tuned. In addition, the variance allowed visible emissions in excess of 20% opacity for more than three minutes in any one-hour.

B. Docket C-07-09E - Rio Bravo Fresno

On July 24, 2007, Hearing Board chairman, Mr. Jerry Boren, approved an emergency variance effective from July 23, 2007, to August 15, 2007. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2520, and 4101 and allowed visible emissions in excess of 20% opacity for more than three minutes until an off-line inspection and repair occurs.
