5. Emergency Variances:

The Central Region Hearing Board approved the following emergency variance orders:

A. <u>Docket #C-05-11E</u> – Canandaigua Wine Company 12667 Road 24, Madera, CA

On July 15, 2005, Hearing Board Chairman James V. Glaser, MD, approved an emergency variance effective from July 16, 2005, to July 17, 2005. Said variance provided relief from the applicable requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4305 to allow operation of subject boiler unit with excess NO_x emissions.

B. <u>Docket #C-05-15E</u> – Hanford LP 10596 Idaho Avenue, Hanford, CA

On September 1, 2005, Hearing Board member Robert Schumacher approved an emergency variance effective from September 1, 2005, to September 11, 2005. Said variance provided relief from the applicable requirements of District Rules 1080 and 2070.7.0 to allow continued operation of the fluidized bed combustor without a CEMS capable of measuring and recording NO_X (as NO_2 corrected to 3% O_2), SO_X (as SO_2 corrected to 3% O_2), and O_2 concentrations while repairs to the CO/O_2 analyzer are completed.
