5. The Central Region Hearing Board approved the following emergency variance orders:

A. Docket #C-05-18E – Aera Energy, LLC

On November 18, 2005, Hearing Board chairman Mr. James V. Glaser, MD, approved an emergency variance effective from November 17, 2005, to December 16, 2005. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, and 4623 to allow AERA to operate the subject equipment without an operational TVRS capable of achieving and maintaining a minimum 99% control efficiency while efforts were made to isolate and repair electrical problems.

B. Docket #C-06-01E – Certainteed Corporation

On January 26, 2006, Hearing Board chairman Mr. James V. Glaser, MD, approved an emergency variance effective on January 31, 2006. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 4101, and 4202 to allow CERTAINTEED to curtail operation of the dry EP serving the glass-melting furnace while three electrical transformers serving the facility were off-gassed.
