On April 21, 2006, Hearing Board member Mr. Jerry Boren denied an emergency variance request. Said variance requested relief from specific requirement of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201 and 4101 to allow continued operation of the glass melting furnace while the exhaust gas bypassed the electrostatic precipitator. At the time of the hearing the facility complied with all District Rules, therefore, the required findings could not be met.

B. <u>Docket #C-06-06E</u> – Shell Pipeline Company LP

On May 2, 2006, Hearing Board member Mr. Jerry Boren approved an emergency variance request. Said variance provided relief from District Rules 2070.7.0, 2520, 4001 and 4703 to allow the continued operation of the subject 39.5 MMBtu/hr Solar Centaur Model 40 S Gas Turbine #2 with natural gas consumption in excess of 650,000 scf/day.
