5. Emergency Variances:

The Central Region Hearing Board had approved the following emergency variance order:

A. Docket #C-03-11E – SFPP, LP 4149 S. Maple Avenue, Fresno, CA

On November 12, 2003, Hearing Board Chairman, James V. Glaser, MD, approved an emergency variance effective from November 10, 2003, to December 9, 2003. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0 and 4623 and allowed gasoline to be stored in Tank FR-17 until the tank could be taken out of service and the primary seal replaced. Additionally, this variance allowed the landing of Tank FR-5 without meeting the required 5-day District notice.
