The following emergency variance orders were approved by the Central Region Hearing Board:

- A. Docket #C-03-18E – Madera Power LLC
11427 Firebaugh Road, Fresno, CA

On February 19, 2004, Hearing Board Chairman, James V. Glaser, MD, approved an emergency variance effective from February 18, 2004, to March 19, 2004. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 4001, and 4703, as they pertain to the continued operation of turbine/generator Unit 1 with intermittent NOx concentration emissions until the SCR catalyst can be replaced.

- B. Docket #C-04-02E – Pacific Gas & Electric Company

On March 3, 2004, Hearing Board Chairman, James V. Glaser, MD, approved an emergency variance effective from March 13, 2004, to March 28, 2004. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4701, as they pertain to the operation of an emergency generator outside permitted periods.

On March 3, 2004, Hearing Board Chairman, James V. Glaser, MD, approved an emergency variance effective from March 12, 2004, to March 31, 2004. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0 and 2201, as they pertain to the operation of a turbine generator unit while undergo multiple start-ups and tuning activities with excess NO_x, CO, and NH₃ emissions.
