1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER:

4. PUBLIC HEARING:

The Chair asked the Clerk to verify that all items had been properly noticed. The Clerk responded that they had. All those present to testify were sworn in by the Chair. The Chair asked that the agenda packet and any addenda brought forth to be entered into the official record.

Patrick Houlihan presented the District report.

Mr. Hilarides explained to the Hearing Board members that he had received the catalytic converters for the test engines, but were

manufactured with errors in the flange length and returned to be corrected. He pointed out that this is typical of problems that can occur with the start up of something that has not been previously done. He stated his concerns with problems such as this and others that could occur which could delay the project. He asked the Board if it was possible to give him 9 months on the variance to allow for problems rather than the 6 months the District had proposed. Patrick Houlihan stated that the District felt it should be kept at 6 months due to the tremendous amount of NO_x from the other engines. But should problems arise that will take this past the 6 month variance period, the petitioner can request the District for additional time.

Patrick stated that he needed to make a change to Condition #12. January 15, 2010 should be replaced with July 15, 2009.

Jerry Mulligan asked if the petitioner needed to come back to extend the variance. The question was put to Catherine Redmond, Legal Counsel. She informed the Board that for public noticing purposes, Mr. Hilarides would need to return and request the additional time if needed.

Patrick informed the Board that the reason the variance was reduced to six months was due to the District's concern with the amount of NO_x that would come from the other engines. Patrick felt it would be better to limit the variance to six months and not require the petitioner to shut down the other four engines.

Discussion continued between the Board members, Mr. Hilarides, and Patrick Houlihan regarding the operation of his dairy, the engines, getting them on line with the new equipment if the tests on the other two are successful, time lines, equipment suppliers, and other dairy digester equipment.

Catherine Redmond, Legal Counsel, informed the Board that typically a regular variance can go up to a year and that the Board can extend the variance beyond the six months currently proposed should the need arise.
