Petitioners: Sangeetha Arunagiri

Patrick Houlihan presented the Staff Report and photos of the facility.

Saint-Gobain Containers has requested a short variance from the applicable requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, 4101, and 4354 in addition to the applicable conditions of the subject PTOs. The requested short variance would begin on December 23, 2013, and end no later than December 28, 2013. If granted, the variance would allow the continued operation of the glass melting furnace, and continued glass production in idle mode, with excess visible emissions while Saint-Gobain Containers shuts down the EP and scrubber to perform required maintenance on the control equipment.

Mr. Boren asked if Furnace 2 will still be in production even though it's in idle mode. Mr. Houlihan responded affirmatively. Mr. Boren asked if maintenance work is being done on the furnace. Mr. Houlihan clarified maintenance is only being done on the scrubber and EP. Mr. Boren asked the time period required to rebuild Furnace 1. Ms. Arunagiri responded the rebuild takes approximately 3 months.

Mr. Mulligan asked what becomes of the collected material in the EP. Ms. Arunagiri explained the collected material goes back into the process and ultimately gets turned back into glass. Mr. Houlihan illustrated the process utilizing the photos.

Ms. Arunagiri stated there are efforts to mitigate emissions.

Having decided the petition has met the required findings, on motion of Mr. Mulligan and seconded by Mr. Hartwig, unanimously passed, the petitioner was granted a short variance.
