Chris Kalashian presented the Staff Report.

Guardian has requested a short variance from the applicable requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, 4101, and 4354 in addition to the applicable conditions of the subject permits. The requested short variance will be from June 19, 2014, until June 30, 2014. If granted, the variance will allow the continued operation of the glass melting furnace and continued glass production, with excess visible emissions while

Guardian shuts down the scrubber, EP and SCR, to perform required maintenance on the control equipment.

Shannon Moore presented the Staff Report.

Algonquin has requested a short variance from District Rules 1080, 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4703 in addition to condition of the applicable permits. The requested short variance would be for 5 consecutive days from July 21, 2014, through July 25, 2014. If granted, the variance would allow Algonquin to operate the subject turbine unit without a Continuous Emissions Monitoring System.

Mr. Moore noted the following modifications to the Recommendations:

1. The variance shall be effective from July 28, 2014, through August 1, 2014, or until the upgrade/replacement project is complete, whichever occurs first.
7. By August 16, 2014, or no later than 15 calendar days after returning the CEMS to operation, whichever occurs first, Algonquin shall submit to the District a summary report.

The petitioners had no comments.

Mr. Hartwig asked if the upgrade and replacement of equipment can be completed in 5 days. Mr. Reed responded affirmatively.
