Mr. Houlihan presented the Staff Report.

Ardagh has requested a short variance from the applicable requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070, 2201, 2520, 4101, and 4354 in addition to the applicable conditions of the subject permits. The requested short variance would be for a consecutive 144 hour period to occur sometime between December 23, 2014, and January 2, 2015, inclusive. If granted, the variance would allow the continued operation of the glass melting furnaces, and continued glass production in idle

mode, with excess visible emissions while Ardagh shuts down the scrubber and EP to perform required maintenance on said emissions control equipment.

Mr. Boren asked the time period expected for the duration of the maintenance. Ms. Arunagiri responded the maintenance would take at least three days to complete.

Mr. Hartwig asked why visible emissions are not addressed in the applicable District rules. Mr. Houlihan explained District Rules are currently being reviewed and Rule 4101 (Visible Emissions) may be modified in the future. He added there is a state law that discusses visible emissions, Section 41701 from the Health and Safety Code and the reason for the variance.

Ms. Arunagiri commented the maintenance is routine and due to excess visible emissions when the facility is shut down there is a need for the variance.

Mr. Mulligan asked if Ms. Arunagiri was in agreement with the staff recommendations. Ms. Arunagiri responded affirmatively.

Having decided the petition has met the required findings, on motion of Dr. Goodwin and seconded by Mr. Mulligan, unanimously passed, the petitioner was granted a short variance.
