GUARDIAN has requested a short variance from the applicable requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, 4101, and CH&SC section 41701, in addition to the applicable conditions of the subject permits. The requested short variance will be for a non-consecutive 48 hour period to occur sometime between June 15, 2021, and September 15, 2021, inclusive. If granted, the variance will allow the continued operation of the glass melting furnace, and continued glass production, with excess visible emissions while GUARDIAN shuts down the emission control devices in order to perform routine maintenance on the EP.

Hearing Board Comments: Mr. Mulligan asked why the variance was for a 3-month length of time. Mr. Roach responded that the facility wants to ensure they have sufficient time to conduct maintenance on the EP should any unexpected issues arise.
