Decision – Board Member Waterman made the motion to grant the Short Variance subject to eleven conditions set forth on pages 4 and 5 of the Staff Report with a revision to #1. Seconded by Board Member Mulligan and carried unanimously.

The Board granted a Short Variance to Docket C-04-04S, SFPP, LP. The variance allowing a temporary throughput increase, to a maximum of 5 million gallons per day, shall be effective for only two 24 hour periods between June 4, 2004 to August 29, 2004, or until the testing of VRS at higher throughputs is completed, whichever occurs first. The Board adopted by reference the required six findings set forth on pages 2 and 3 of the Staff Report. The Short Variance shall be subject to eleven conditions with a revision to # 1, the conditions shall be set forth in the Hearing Board Order.
