Philip M. Jay, District Counsel, announced that Meggin Boranian, Attorney at Law, would be representing the Hearing Board. Mr. Jay indicated his office is involved in the Foster Farms permitting matter and did not believe it would be appropriate if someone from his office sat with the Hearing Board, because his office has been very involved in advising staff regarding this matter.

Mr. Jay suggested the following format, staff go first, perhaps followed by Foster Farms, since they are aligned with staff, and then the petitioner, but he would defer to Ms. Boranian.

Mr. Jay noted that technically there are two appeals on the docket today. The issues in both are identical, so the Hearing Board may want to consolidate the two petitions together, but take a separate vote on each one.

Mr. Jay provided the Hearing Board with background and history information regarding this issue.

Samir Sheikh, Permit Services Manager, introduced information about what Foster Farms is all about.

Dave Duke, Doug Stabelfeld and Elizabeth Weaver represented Foster Farms.

Mr. Stabelfeld provided an overhead presentation to the Hearing Board, staff and the Petitioner.

Avinash Kar and Caroline Farrell represented the Center on Race, Poverty and the Environment.
