Docket No. C-01-05S, Short Variance, Darling International, Inc., 795 Belgravia Avenue, Fresno, CA. 93630. Type of Business: Animal Matter Rendering Facility.

<u>Petitioner</u> – Bill McMurtry represented Darling International, Inc.

<u>Public Comments</u> – No Public Comments.

<u>Decision</u> – A motion was made by Mr. Schumahcer to grant the variance with eleven conditions set forth on pages 3 and 4 of the Staff Report the conditions were amended during the Hearing. The motion was seconded by Mr. Lewis and carried unanimously. The Board discussed the required six findings set forth on pages 2 and 3 of the Staff Report and concurred the six findings could be made.

Therefore, the Board granted a Short Variance to Docket No. C-01-05S, Darling International, Inc. The variance shall be effective from March 5, 2001 to May 31, 2001. The variance is subject to eleven conditions with amendments to the following conditions:

- #1. The variance period shall be effective from March 21, 2001 March 5, 2001 to May 31, 2001 or until the Petitioner can demonstrate compliance with the current permitted NOx emission levels, whichever occurs first.

 However, if the Petitioner can demonstrate it has not exceeded 2,748 gallons per day of yellow grease, the start date can be modified to the date of application March 5, 2001.
- #7. The maximum amount of yellow grease combusted shall not exceed 2,748 3,863 from March 5, 2001 through March 21, 2001 and the limit from today on shall not exceed 2,748 gallons/day to the end of the variance period.
