# A. <u>N-18-09E</u> - Modesto Irrigation District

On July 27, 2018, Hearing Board Vice Chair, Gerald Schneider, acting for and on behalf of the Northern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from July 27, 2018, through August 25, 2018. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4703 and allowed for continued operation of the combustion turbine generator while maintenance was being performed on the  $NO_X$  water injection system.

### B. N-18-10E - Chevron Banta Terminal

On July 27, 2018, Hearing Board Vice Chair, Gerald Schneider, acting for and on behalf of the Northern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from July 27, 2018, through August 26, 2018. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2520, and 4623 and allowed for continued operation of the internal floating roof tank while defects in the secondary seal were repaired.

## C. <u>N-18-12E</u> - Ripon Unified School District

On October 9, 2018, Hearing Board Chair, Mark Kanai, acting for and on behalf of the Northern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from October 10, 2018, through November 8, 2018. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 1081, 2070, 2201, 4701, and 4702 and allowed for the postponement of the biennial compliance source test until the head gasket and engine control unit were repaired.
