10. The Northern Region Hearing Board heard and granted the following emergency variances:

A. N-20-08E SunOpta Grains and Foods Inc.

On June 23, 2020, Hearing Board Chair, Mark Kanai, acting for and on behalf of the Northern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from June 22, 2020, through July 21, 2020. The variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 4305, 4306, and 4320 and allowed SunOpta to postpone the compliance source test while they repair the SCR catalyst.

B. N-20-09E J.R. Simplot Lathrop

On July 8, 2020, Hearing Board Vice-Chair, Gerald Schneider, acting for and on behalf of the Northern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from July 6, 2020, through July 11, 2020. The variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070, 2520, 4101, and California Health and Safety Code Section 41701 and allowed the facility to start back up with excess visible emissions released during and while this start-up is finalized.
