- 10. The Northern Region Hearing Board heard, and granted, the following emergency variances since the November 3, 2021, hearing.
 - A. N-22-02E Darling Ingredients Inc.

On January 19, 2022, Hearing Board Chair, Mark Kanai, acting for and on behalf of the Northern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from January 12, 2022, through January 28, 2022. The variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4101, and allowed Darling Ingredients Inc. to continue operating while the RTO was repaired and returned to compliant operation.

B. N-22-05E Owens-Brockway Glass Container Inc.

On April 5, 2022, Hearing Board member, Rob Hofmann, acting for and on behalf of the Northern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from March 30, 2022, through April 28, 2022. The variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 1080, 2070, 2201, 2520, 4101, 4354 and CH&SC Section 41701 and allowed Owens-Brockway Glass Container Inc. to continue operating without emission control devices while a new ID fan on the EP furnace was installed.
