Emergency Variances:

The Southern Region Hearing Board approved the following emergency variance order:

A. <u>Docket #N-04-08E</u> – G-3 Enterprises – Closure Division

On September 15, 2004, Hearing Board Chairman Mr. Mark Kanai, Esq., approved an emergency variance effective from September 15, 2004, to October 13, 2004. Said variance provided relief from the specific requirements of Section 5.1.1 of District Rule 4653 to allow the continued operation of the PVC capsule production line while using a PVC welding adhesive (Dekapren 1513/14) with a VOC content of 646.1 grams per liter during the variance period.

B. <u>Docket #N-04-09E</u> – Stockton Cogen Company

On November 1, 2004, Hearing Board Chairman Mr. Mark Kanai, Esq., approved an emergency variance effective from October 30, 2004, to midnight on November 4, 2004. Said variance provided relief from the specific requirements of Section 7.0 of District Rule 2070 to allow the operation of the circulating fluidized bed boiler at reduced load during the variance period with excess emissions.
