5. Emergency Variances:

The Northern Region Hearing Board approved the following emergency variance orders:

- A. Docket #N-05-14E – Original Productions

On August 9, 2005, Hearing Board member Mr. Donald Ohlinger approved an emergency variance effective August 10, 2005. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 4101 and 4103 to allow the open burning of straw, hay bails, a scarecrow made of straw, propane-filled balloons, and food items for special effects filming.

B. Docket #N-05-15E – Geer Road Landfill

On August 16, 2005, Hearing Board member Mr. Mark Kanai, Esq., approved an emergency variance effective from August 15, 2005, to September 13, 2005. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2080, 2201, 2520, and 4642 to allow the continued operation of the solid waste landfill without a gas collection system operated in such a manner that the surface emissions of total organic compounds do not exceed 1,000 parts per million by volume at any point of the surface of the solid waste disposal site or along the gas transfer path of the gas collection system.
