The Northern Region Hearing Board approved the following emergency variance orders:

- A. Docket # N-03-03E – Owens-Brockway Glass Container, Inc.
14700 W. Schulte Road, Tracy, CA 95377

On January 29, 2003, Northern Region Hearing Board Chairman, Mr. Mark Kanai, Esq., approved an emergency variance effective from January 24, 2003, to February 22, 2003. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rule 2070.7.0 as it pertains to bypassing the EP while B-Furnace and its associated control equipment are temporarily repaired.

- B. Docket # N-03-04E – Pilkington North America
500 E. Louise Avenue, Lathrop, CA 95330

On February 3, 2003, Northern Region Hearing Board Member, Mr. Donald Ohlinger, approved an emergency variance effective from January 29, 2003, to February 24, 2003. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 4201, and 4202 as they pertain to continued operation of the glass-melting furnace with excess PM emissions, until the baghouse bags can be replaced.

On April 8, 2003, Northern Region Hearing Board Chairman, Mr. Mark Kanai, Esq., approved an emergency variance effective from April 7, 2003, to April 11, 2003. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 1080 and 2070.7.0 as they pertain to the continued operation of the glass-melting furnace while the CEMS is inoperative and under repair.

On May 14, 2003, Northern Region Hearing Board Member, Mr. Gerald Schneider, approved an emergency variance effective from June 23, 2003, to July 23, 2003. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rule 1081, 2010, 2201, and 4305 as they pertain to the operation of the boiler/burner with excess NOx and CO emissions while tuning and testing are conducted.
