Patrick Houlihan presented the report. He noted that while George Reed originally applied for an ATC variance to produce 6000 tons of asphalt per day, they were only allowed 1477 tons per day of asphalt, per the ATC. He stated George Reed has already applied for an Authority to Construct (ATC) to allow 4,615 tons per day, which should be granted later in April or early May. Mr. Taylor stated that as soon as Cal Trans determines the nighttime temperatures are adequate, George Reed is required by contract to begin paving, and this variance is required to allow them to produce more asphalt than their current ATC allows, as Cal Trans requires. George Reed has been working with the District to get their public noticing requirement done for a new ATC with higher production limits. Mr. Kanai asked why the original application was revised from 6000 tons/day to 1477 tons/day. Mr. Houlihan stated that District staff, in working with George Reed, determined if the company would accept the lower production rate, they would not have to go through the public notification process; however, George Reed could apply for a higher limit and go through the public notification process at a later time.
