PES has requested a short variance from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0 and 2201 in addition to the applicable conditions of the PTOs. The requested short variance would be for a consecutive 48 hour period to occur sometime between June 6, 2012 and June 30, 2012, inclusive. If

granted the variance would allow for continued ethanol production while the RTO and scrubbers are shut down for preventative maintenance.

Having decided the petition has met the required findings, on motion of Mr. Benak and seconded by Mr. Gohring, unanimously passed, the petitioner was granted a short variance.

B. N-12-07R Regular Fiscalini Farms & Fiscalini Dairy

Petitioners: John Fiscalini and Nettie Drake

Patrick Houlihan presented the Staff Report.

FISCALINI has requested a regular variance from District Rules 2010, 2201, and 4801 in addition to the applicable condition on the subject ATC. The requested regular variance period would be from June 6, 2012, until June 5, 2013. If granted, the variance would allow the H_2S concentration of the biogas fuel to exceed 50 ppmv until FISCALINI's planned procedures reduce the concentration below 50 ppmv.

Ms. Drake modified the request to increase the time limit to December 31, 2012 to submit to the District a written plan that specifies how they will come into compliance with the H_2S limit. She also requested the H_2S limit be increased to 500 ppmv during the variance period.

Dr. Benak asked how many complaints the facility has received about H₂S odor. Mr. Fiscalini responded that no complaints have been made.

Mr. Schneider asked for clarification of the District's recommendations regarding the ending of the variance. Mr. Hayashi explained the ending of the variance as listed in the recommendations were made without the knowledge of proposed experimental exemption and will be revised.

Mr. Schneider asked how a new system can have BACT and how the H_2S concentrations are set at 50 ppmv when there's no other technology to illustrate BACT. Mr. Ramon explained BACT is required by District Rule 2201 and the 50 ppmv was based on what was achieved in practice by other digester type sources. He added that because of the uniqueness of the operation staff would consider increasing the limit to 85 ppmv. Mr. Ramon explained the BACT can never be above a rule limit so the operation will be reviewed as a unique category of source and review any documentation that would justify a higher limit.

Public Comments: None

Having decided the petition has met the required findings, on motion of Mr. Gohring and seconded by Dr. Benak, unanimously passed, the petitioner was granted a regular variance with the modifications requested.
