PES has requested a short variance from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0 and 2201 in addition to the applicable conditions of the PTOs. The requested short variance would be for a consecutive 48 hour period to occur sometime between October 4, 2012, and December 8, 2012, inclusive. If granted,

the variance would allow for continued ethanol production while the RTO and scrubbers are shut down for preventative maintenance.

Patrick Houlihan presented the Staff Report.

LEC has requested an interim variance, to be followed by a regular variance, from the requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, 4305, 4306, and 4320 in addition to conditions of the subject PTO and ATC. The requested variance period would be for a period to occur from October 3, 2012, until December 5, 2012, or until the hearing for the regular variance can be heard. If granted, the variance would allow the auxiliary boiler to operate with excess CO emissions and would provide for the postponement of the compliance source test.

Mr. Houlihan explained the following modifications to the petition:

- LEC started the auxiliary boiler on September 14, 2012 and determined, via use of portable emissions analyzer, that the CO emissions were above the permit limit of 50 parts per million by volume (ppmv).
- Condition 1: The variance shall be effective from September 19, 2012, until December 5, 2012 or until the Northern Region has heard the petition for the regular variance, or if the auxiliary boilers CO emissions achieve compliance and a compliance source test is initiated, whichever occurs first.
- Condition 2B: Conditions # 15, 26, 37 & 38 of ATC N-2697-7-0

Mr. Adkins informed the Board the equipment is scheduled for delivery on October 8, 2012 and will install soon after.

Mr. Scheflo asked how often the auxiliary boiler will be brought online. Mr. DeBortoli explained the auxiliary boiler is used to start the facility, but it is not run continuously. Mr. Schneider asked how often is the auxiliary boiler started and stopped once the facility is running. Mr. DeBortoli explained LEC analyzed 256 starts per year.

Having decided the petition has met the required findings, on motion of Mr. Schneider and seconded by Mr. Scheflo, unanimously passed, the petitioner was granted an interim variance.

RECOLOGY has requested a short variance from District Rules 2070.7.0 and 2201, in addition to conditions of the applicable Permit to Operate (PTO). RECOLOGY has requested that the short variance be effective from October 3, 2012, until December 31, 2012. If granted, the variance would allow RECOLOGY to exceed its annual permitted hour limit on the subject diesel engine.

Mr. Houlihan reported the District does not believe the Hearing Board has jurisdiction over this matter. Mr. Kanai asked Ms. Williamson if the Board has jurisdiction. Ms. Williamson explained this matter comes under state law and the Board does not have jurisdiction over this matter. Mr. Kanai asked when the petitioner knew the Board did not have jurisdiction. Mr. Houlihan explained the petitioners were advised on September 27, 2012. He added the petitioners wished to attend to be able to speak to staff after Hearing Board meeting.

Mr. Kanai stated the Northern Region Hearing Board having no jurisdiction over the matter cannot proceed and the petitioner was not granted a short variance.
