3. Approve Minutes of July 3, 2013

The Vice Chair asked if there were comments regarding the Minutes for July 3, 2013. Hearing no comments, the Chair declared the minutes were approved as submitted.

The Chair swore in all those present to testify for all matters.

Ms. Williamson requested more information on the possible conflict of interest from Mr. Hofmann. Mr. Hofmann stated he represented Pacific Ethanol Inc from Fresno which predated the existing LLC. He noted he did not know the affiliation between the two companies. Ms. Williamson requested confirmation Mr. Hofmann represented the company in 2005/2006 and has not represented the company in any capacity since then. Mr. Hofmann responded affirmatively. Ms. Williamson stated she did not view this situation as a conflict of interest.

Ms. Williamson asked all parties if there were any objections with Mr. Hofmann serving on the Northern Region Hearing Board hearing testimony on the matters regarding Pacific Ethanol Stockton, LLC. Mr. Houlihan stated the District has no objection. Mr. Schneider stated the Board has no objection. Mr. Cook stated the petitioner has no objection. There was no public comment.

Patrick Houlihan presented the Staff Report.

PES has requested a short variance from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, and 4623 in addition to the applicable conditions of the subject PTOs. The requested short variance would be for a consecutive 48 hour period to occur sometime between September 16, 2013 and October 7, 2013, inclusive. If granted, the variance would allow for continued ethanol production while the RTO and scrubbers are shut down for preventative maintenance.

Mr. Cook stated he had no further comments.

Mr. Schneider asked if the excess emission fees will begin with the first pound if the total excess emissions go over 2,000 lbs. Mr. Houlihan responded affirmatively.

Mr. Hofmann requested clarification on the ability of the facility to shut down. Mr. Cook explained shutting down the facility to a point there were no emissions would mean draining and thorough cleaning every vessel in the facility. Mr. Hofmann requested an estimated cost incurred for a shut down. Mr. Cook responded the cost would be in excess of \$1 million.

Having decided the petition has met the required findings, on motion of Mr. Schneider and seconded by Mr. Gohring, unanimously passed, the petitioner was granted a regular variance.
