Chris Kalashian presented the Staff Report.

TID has requested a short variance from the applicable requirements of District Rules 1080, 2201, 2070.7.0, 2520, 4001, and 4703 in addition to the applicable conditions of the subject permits. The requested short variance period would be from June 25, 2014, to July 30, 2014. If granted, the variance would allow the continued operation of the subject turbine without a certified CEMS.

Mr. Kalashian noted the following recommendations were modified:

- 1. The variance shall be effective from June 25, 2014, until September 22, 2014.
- 8. By October 7, 2014, or no later than 15 calendar days after certifying the CEMS, whichever occurs first, TID shall submit to the District a summary report.
