AltaGas has requested a short variance from District Rule 1080, 2070, 2201, 2520, 4001, and 4703 in addition to conditions of the applicable permits. The requested short variance would be for 60 consecutive days to occur between July 15, 2017, through September 12, 2017. If granted, the variance would allow AltaGas to operate the subject facility without a certified CEMS while the analyzers are replaced and the system is recertified.

The petitioner had no further comments.
