Docket N-03-17R, Regular Variance, Modesto Irrigation District, 920 Woodland Avenue, Modesto, CA. 95351. Type of Business: Electrical Power Generating Facility.

<u>Petitioners</u> – Jeff Adkins and Greg Salyer represented Modesto Irrigation District.

James Swaney provided additional testimony for the District.

Public Comment - No Public Comment.

<u>Decision</u> – Board Member Ohlinger made the motion to grant the variance with the Board concurring the required six findings set forth on pages 2 and 3 of the Staff Report could be met. The variance shall be subject to ten conditions that were modified during the hearing. Seconded by Board Member Benak and carried unanimously with the following *Roll Call Vote*:

The Board granted a Regular Variance to Docket N-03-17R, Modesto Irrigation District. The variance shall be effective from December 11, 2003 to May 19, 2004, or until the date the modified Title V permit incorporating the ATC applications under Project No. N1032119 is issued, whichever occurs sooner.

The following recommendations were modified to read:

- 1. The variance shall be effective from November 19, 2003 December 11, 2003, to May 19, 2004, or until the date, Permit Services takes final action on the modified Title V permit incorporating the ATC applications under Project No. N1032219 is issued, whichever occurs sooner.
- 3. Variance relief shall allow the continued operation of Unit-2 using natural gas with a sulfur content in excess of the permit limit until Permit Services takes final action on the modified Title V permit incorporating the ATC applications under Project No. N1032119 is issued.

- 6. <u>Effective January 7, 2004,</u> throughout the <u>remainder of the</u> variance period, the Petitioner shall sample and record the actual fuel gas sulfur content weekly.

By June 2, 2004, or 15 days after Permit Services takes final action on the modified Title V permit incorporating the ATC applications under Project No. N1032119 is issued, whichever occurs sooner, the Petitioner shall submit to the District a written report that includes the following information:

The ten conditions with the above modifications shall be set forth in the Order.
