The Southern Region Hearing Board approved the following emergency variances orders:

A. Docket S-08-76E – Big West of California, LLC

On November 12, 2008, Hearing Board chairman Hollis Carlile approved an emergency variance from November 10, 2008 to December 9, 2008. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, 4305, and 4306 and allowed the continued operation of three heaters in violation of emissions limits and permit conditions.

B. <u>Docket S-08-79E</u> - Kern River Cogeneration Company

On November 24, 2008, Hearing Board member Kimm Wolber RN, COHN-S approved an emergency variance from November 19, 2008 to December 18, 2008. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4703 and allowed the continued operation of the turbine until new nozzles can be installed and performance tests conducted.

C. Docket S-08-80E – Covanta Delano, Inc.

On November 24, 2008, Hearing Board member Kimm Wolber RN, COHN-S approved an emergency variance from November 23, 2008 to December 22, 2008. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070, 2201, and 2520 and allowed the continued operation of the fuel handling system without operating fabric collector BH4.
