5. The Southern Region Hearing Board approved the following emergency variances orders since the December 23, 2008 Hearing:

A. Docket S-09-02E – Aera Energy, LLC

On January 12, 2009, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, approved an emergency variance from January 23, 2009 to January 26, 2009. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4623 and allowed the continued operation of petroleum storage tanks without an operational vapor recovery system.

B. Docket S-09-03E – Big West of California, LLC

On January 22, 2009, Hearing Board member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from January 21, 2009, to February 20, 2009. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070, 2520, 4305, 4306, and 4351 and allowed the continued operation of several process heaters with excess emissions.

C. Docket S-09-11E – Aera Energy, LLC

On February 2, 2009, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, approved an emergency variance from February 3, 2009 to February 10, 2009.
