5. The Southern Region Hearing Board granted the following emergency variances orders:

A. Docket S-09-58E – Plains Production & Exploration.

On October 12, 2009, Hearing Board Chair Mr. Hollis Carlile acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board approved an emergency variance from October 12, 2009 to October 15, 2009. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4401 and allowed the thermally enhanced oil recovery operation to continue without an operational well vent vapor recovery system until the vapor compressor can be repaired.

B. Docket S-09-59E – Occidental of Elk Hills, Inc.

On October 13, 2009, Hearing Board Chair Mr. Hollis Carlile acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from October 19, 2009 to October 23, 2009. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070, 2201, and 4623 and allowed the subject storage tanks at the Buena Vista Hills to continue to store VOC containing liquids without an operational vapor recovery system.
