5. The Southern Region Hearing Board granted the following emergency variances orders:

A. <u>Docket S-10-03E</u> – Aera Energy, LLC

On January 19, 2010, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board approved an emergency variance from January 19, 2010, until February 17, 2010. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070, 2201, 2520, 4401 and 4623 and allowed for the storage of VOC containing liquids in tanks without an operating VRS.

B. Docket S-10-05E – Pacific Pipeline System, LLC

On January 22, 2010 Hearing Board member, Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, CLNC, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board approved an emergency variance from January 21, 2010 to January 28, 2010. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070 and 4623 and allowed a floating roof tank to land on its legs without proper notice and to remain on its legs for the duration of the variance.
