5. The Southern Region Hearing Board granted the following emergency variances since the last Hearing:

A. <u>Docket S-10-34E</u> – Chevron USA, Inc.

On June 3, 2010, Hearing Board Chair, Mr. Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board approved an emergency variance from June 10, 2010, until July 9, 2010. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4623 and allowed for the storage of VOC containing liquids in tanks without a functional or operating vapor recovery system.

B. <u>Docket S-10-36E</u> – Crimson Resource Management

On June 23, 2010, Hearing Board member, Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, CLNC, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board approved an emergency variance from June 25, 2010, until July 24, 2010. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, and 2520, and allowed the flaring of processed gas over the permit limit of 300 mscf per day until Crimson is able to sell the gas to Chevron again.
