On October 21, 2010, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board approved an emergency variance from October 21, 2010, until October 27, 2010. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4623 and allowed for the storage of VOC containing liquids in tanks without a functional or operating vapor recovery system at the Monterey Central Plant in the Kern River Oil Field.

B. Docket S-10-65E – Aera Energy, LLC

On October 29, 2010, Hearing Board member, Kimm Wolber, COHN-S, CLNC, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board approved an emergency variance from October 29, 2010, until October 30, 2010. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4623 and allowed for the storage of VOC containing liquids in tanks without a functional or operating vapor recovery system at the MOCO, D&E Sands, Kendon, Lilly, National, Nevada, PRU, and Siemens leases in the Midway Sunset Oil Field.
