On May 5, 2011, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from May 7, 2011 to June 5, 2011. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4703 and allowed for excess NO<sub>x</sub> and CO emissions while the cogeneration unit undergoes performance testing.

- A. Docket S-11-27E – Kern Oil & Refining Company

On May 13, 2011, Hearing Board member, Kimm Wolber RN, COHN-S, CLNC acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from May 13, 2011, to May 14, 2011. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4623 and allowed for the continued operation of the subject petroleum storage tanks without an operational vapor recovery system.
