5. The Southern Region Hearing Board granted the following emergency variances since the September 14, 2011, Hearing:

A. Docket S-11-56E – Land O' Lakes

On September 30, 2011, Hearing Board member, John Stovall, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from September 30, 2011, to October 29, 2011. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 1080, 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4320 and allowed for the postponement of the annual compliance source test.

B. Docket S-11-60E – SunnyGem, LLC

On October 5, 2011, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from October 6, 2011, to November 4, 2011. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070, 2201, 4305, 4306, and 4320 and allowed for the start up of the boiler without the selective catalytic reduction (SCR) in place.
