5. The Southern Region Hearing Board granted the following emergency variances since the October 12, 2011, Hearing:

A. <u>Docket S-11-61E</u> – Aera Energy, LLC

On October 13, 2011, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from October 12, 2011, until November 10, 2011. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070, and 2520 and allowed for the opening of the subject tanks to allow for inspection, repair, and testing of pressure relief devices.

B. <u>Docket S-11-62E</u> – Alon Bakersfield Refining

On October 25, 2011, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from October 25, 2011, to November 23, 2011. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, 4305, 4306, and 4320 and allowed for subject heater to operate without the selective catalytic reduction (SCR) in place, while the SCR was cleaned.

C. Docket S-11-64E – Chevron USA, Inc.

On October 26, 2011, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from October 25, 2011, to November 23, 2011. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4623 and allowed for three petroleum storage tanks to vent to atmosphere due to a third-parties inability to receive the tank vapor recovery vapors.
