A. Docket S-11-47E – Alon Bakersfield Refining

On August 25, 2011, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis B. Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from August 25, 2011, to September 23, 2011.
