B. S-12-34E - Macpherson Oil Company

On July 11, 2012, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from July 11, 2012, until August 9, 2012. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, and 4623 and allowed for the storage of VOC containing liquids without a functional or operating vapor recovery system.

C. S-12-35E - Plains Exploration & Production Company

On July 16, 2012, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from July 15, 2012, and July 30, 2012. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, and 4623 and allowed for the storage of VOC containing liquids without a functional or operating vapor recovery system.

D. S-12-36E - Crimson Resource Management

On July 19, 2012, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from July 16, 2012, and August 14, 2012. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 2520 and allowed the flare to exceed its annual flow volume.

E. S-12-37E - Delta Trading, LP

On July 20, 2012, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from July 20, 2012, and August 18, 2012. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 and allowed for the storage of VOC containing liquids without a functional or operating vapor recovery system.

F. S-12-38E - Aera Energy, LLC

On July 24, 2012, Hearing Board Vice Chair, William Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from July 21, 2012, and August 19, 2012. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, and 4311 and allowed for the continued operation of the low pressure flare without monitoring and reporting of the vent gas flow rates.

G. S-12-41E - Aera Energy, LLC

On August 1, 2012, Hearing Board Vice Chair, William Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from August 1, 2012, and August 30, 2012. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, and 4623 and allowed for the storage of VOC containing liquids without a functional or operating vapor recovery system.

H. S-12-42E - Chevron USA, Inc.

On August 2, 2012, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from August 3, 2012, and August 7, 2012. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, and 4623 and allowed for the storage of VOC containing liquids without a functional or operating vapor recovery system.
