5. The Southern Region Hearing Board has granted the following emergency variances:

A. S-12-63E - Aera Energy, LLC (Midway Sunset Cogeneration Company)

On October 25, 2012, Hearing Board Vice Chair, Bill Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance for the day of October 30, 2012. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, and 4703 and allowed for the continued operation of one of the combustion turbine generators with excess NO_x emissions.

B. S-12-65E - Aera Energy, LLC

On October 31, 2012, Hearing Board Vice Chair, Bill Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from October 31, 2012, until November 2, 2012. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, and 4623 and allowed for the storage of VOC containing liquids without a functional or operating vapor recovery system.
