- A. <u>S-12-49E</u> Kern Oil & Refining Company

On September 11, 2012, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from September 11, 2012, until September 14, 2012. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2520, and 4623 and allowed for the storage of VOC containing liquids without a functional or operating vapor recovery system.

B. <u>S-12-53E</u> - Plains Exploration & Production Company

On September 26, 2012, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from September 25, 2012, until October 24, 2012. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2080, 2201, 2520, 4305, 4306, and 4320 and allowed for the continued operation of two steam generators with inaccurate fuel meters and for the period of time until the next compliance source test.

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C. <u>S-12-54E</u> - Alon Bakersfield Refining

On September 27, 2012, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from September 26, 2012, until October 25, 2012. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, and 4623 and allowed for the storage of VOC containing liquids without a functional or operating vapor recovery system.

D. <u>S-12-59E</u> - Heck Cellars Winery

On September 28, 2012, Hearing Board Chair, Hollis Carlile, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from September 29, 2012, until October 29, 2012. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0 and 2201 and allowed for the continued use of the brandy storing operation without the control of the regenerative thermal oxidizer.
