- 5. The Southern Region Hearing Board heard and granted the following emergency variances:
- A. S-13-09E Vintage Production California, LLC

On March 14, 2013, Hearing Board Chair, William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from March 14, 2013, until March 20, 2013. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, and 4623, and allowed the continued storage of VOC containing liquids in four storage tanks without a functional operating vapor recovery system.

B. <u>S-13-17E</u> - ExxonMobil Production Company

On April 1, 2013, Hearing Board Chair, William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from April 1, 2013, until April 30, 2013. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 and allowed water tank T-1 to be isolated from the vapor recovery system for repair after discovering a liquid leak.
