5. The Southern Region Hearing Board heard and granted the following emergency variances since the October 9, 2013, Hearing:

A. S-13-52E - Chevron USA Inc.

On October 14, 2013, Hearing Board Chair, Mr. William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from October 14, 2013, until November 12, 2013. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, 4401, and 4623 and allowed for the continued storage of VOC containing liquids in the subject tanks without a functional or operating vapor recovery system.

B. S-13-53E - Chevron USA Inc.

On October 14, 2013, Hearing Board Chair, Mr. William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from October 14, 2013, until November 12, 2013. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4401 and allowed for the continued production of oil from wells whose casing gas collection system VRS was offline.

C. S-13-61E - Chevron USA Inc.

On November 12, 2013, Hearing Board Chair, Mr. William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from November 11, 2013, until November 21, 2013. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, 4401, and 4623 and allowed for the continued storage of VOC containing liquids in the subject tanks without a functional or operating vapor recovery system.

D. <u>S-13-62E</u> - ExxonMobil Production Company
