- A. S-13-37E Crimson Resource Management

On August 6, 2013, Hearing Board Chair, William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from August 12, 2013, until August 16, 2013. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 and allowed the continued storage of VOC containing liquids in the subject storage tanks without a functional or operating vapor recovery system.

B. <u>S-13-38E</u> - Chevron USA, Inc.

On August 12, 2013, Hearing Board Vice-Chair, Mr. John Stovall, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from August 12, 2013, until August 18, 2013. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, 4401, and 4623 and allowed for the continued storage of VOC containing liquids in the subject tanks without a functional or operating vapor recovery system.

B. S-13-39E - Freeport-McMoRan Oil and Gas

On August 16, 2013, Hearing Board Chair, William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from August 15, 2013, until August 21, 2013. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, and 4401 and allowed the continued operation of a thermally enhanced oil recovery operation without a functional or operating vapor recovery system.
