5. The Southern Region Hearing Board has granted the following emergency variances since the July 9, 2014, hearing:

# A. <u>S-14-40E</u> - Alon Bakersfield Refining

On July 10, 2014, Hearing Board Chair, William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from July 10, 2014, and August 8, 2014. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 1080, 2070, and 2520 and allowed ALON to continue to operate the Area 1 Flare without continuously recording the H<sub>2</sub>S content of the gas vapors while repair procedures are conducted on the H<sub>2</sub>S analyzer.

## B. S-14-41E - Chevron USA Inc.

On July 15, 2014, Hearing Board Chair, William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from July 14, 2014, and July 31, 2014. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2520, 4305, 4306, and 4320 and afforded CUSA protection from conducting monitoring with a portable combustion analyzer on the subject steam generator within five days of restarting in the month of July 2014, and if repairs cannot be completed within the month of July 2014, to waive the July 2014 monitoring requirement.
