5. The Southern Region Hearing Board has granted the following emergency variances since the November 12, 2015, hearing and the posting of this agenda:

A. <u>S-15-58E</u> - Bluescope Buildings North America Inc

On November 12, 2015, Hearing Board Chair, William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from November 10, 2015, to December 9, 2015. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, and 4603 and allowed for the continued coating of metal parts without the thermal oxidizer in operation or with it operating at less than optimum destruction efficiency until the carbon is rejuvenated and a compliance source test initiated.

B. <u>S-15-63E</u> - Mt Poso Cogeneration Company LLC

On November 30, 2015, Hearing Board Chair, William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from November 30, 2015, to December 4, 2015. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 1080, 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4352 and allowed for the continued operation of the plant without a compliant continuous emissions monitoring system (CEMS).
