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5. The Southern Region Hearing Board has granted the following emergency variances:

A. <u>S-15-30E</u> - Chevron USA Inc

On May 21, 2015, Hearing Board Chair, William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from April 28, 2015, until April 30, 2015. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, 4401, and 4623 and allowed petroleum storage tanks to continue to store VOC containing liquids without a functional or operating vapor recovery system at the 26C Oil Cleaning Plant.
