5. The Southern Region Hearing Board has granted the following emergency variances:

A. S-15-64E - Freeport-McMoRan Oil & Gas

On December 7, 2015, Hearing Board Chair, William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from December 6, 2015, to December 15, 2015. Said variance provided relief from applicable requirements of District Rules 2070, 2520, and 4401 and allowed for the continued operation of oil production wells without an operating casing gas collection system.

B. S-15-66E - Chevron USA Inc.

On December 10, 2015, Hearing Board Chair, William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from December 10, 2015, to December 19, 2015. Said variance provided relief from applicable requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, 4401, and 4623 and allowed for the continued storage of organic liquids in petroleum storage tanks without a functional or operating vapor recovery system while the system underwent repair.

C. <u>S-15-67E</u> - Aera Energy LLC

On December 16, 2015, Hearing Board Chair, William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from December 16, 2015, to December 30, 2015. Said variance provided relief from applicable requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, 4001, and 4703 and allowed for the continued operation of the subject cogeneration unit without a functioning ammonia meter until it was replaced.

D. S-15-72E - Chevron USA Inc.

On December 28, 2015, Hearing Board Chair, William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from December 26, 2015, to December 27, 2015. Said variance provided relief from applicable requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, 4401, and 4623 and allowed for the continued storage of organic liquids in petroleum storage tanks without a functional or operating vapor recovery system while the system underwent maintenance.
